MORECO Common Declaration

“Smart locations and alternative means of transport to the car for a better liveability”

The seven Alpine partner regions in the MORECO (*MO*bility and *RE*sidential *CO*sts) Alpine Space project have been cooperating for the past three years and have identified mechanisms to minimise peri-urbanisation and commuting by car in the Alpine areas.

The economic, environmental and social costs incurred by the residential choice of households should now be more transparent and take into account the intrinsic link between housing and mobility in order to be:

- Effectively considered by the local population when defining their residential choices
- Included in public spatial planning policies at both investment- and operational levels

Given the outcomes of the project, the partners have defined the following four strategic priorities:

- Promote projects around existing and future public transport hubs
- Provide households with tools in order to rationalise their residential choices with regard to residence/mobility costs
- Reduce commuting by car and encourage the use of collective means of transport
- Strive to objectively evaluate the respective costs of urban sprawl and rebuilding the inner city or local neighbourhoods

These priorities for action will be supported and made sustainable by the creation of a network in which the MORECO partners will continue the exchange of experiences and good practices.
